2010 Subscriber-Grower Agreement

Subscribers will receive a basket of produce each week for a total of 20 weeks, running from June 1, 2010 thru October 16, 2010. The assortment of produce will vary throughout the season. Baskets will be filled with a variety of produce such as sweet corn, butterbeans, tomatoes, peppers, and squash, just to name a few. If you would like a more customized basket, please contact us at least one week in advance to select your produce. We cannot guarantee any particular item, but will do our best to accommodate your choices.

1. Subscribers may purchase a Full Share Subscription (average \$25.00 worth of produce per week) or Half Share Subscription (average \$15.00 worth of produce per week). Subscribers may pay the full amount a registration, or make a deposit at registration, with the full amount due by June 1, 2010. A deposit of \$150.00 is required at sign-up.

2. Subscribers are responsible for picking up baskets at the designated day and time. Subscribers are encouraged to find friends or family to pick up their share if they will be away. *This agreement represents a season-long contract with Clarke Farm. If for any reason a member must end their subscription, we will transfer your share to an individual of your choice. If for any reason, a member is unable to pick up their weekly share, arrangements should be made to have someone pick up their share, or the share will be donated to the local food bank or homeless shelter.*
